**Description:**

Gang culture on the East Coast has evolved to a level of complexity and sophistication that is currently defying traditional methods of identification. New gangs have emerged, while others have been eliminated or discontinued. Power shifts have occurred within territorial and penitentiary hierarchical structures. Typical unifying identifiers are becoming increasingly avoided, and gangs are betting on your reliance of outdated information to be written off as a neighborhood crew, or local issue to continue to conduct organized criminal activity without detection. A proactive investigator armed with current gang culture trends will quickly discover a link between the most violent crime in his or her area and gang affiliation.

In addition, growing negative sentiment towards law enforcement and numerous violent attacks on police and correctional officers have placed us in a position where the most violent security threat groups must be proactively identified, and not underestimated or taken lightly. This

course is designed to provide critical information and updates on the East Coast evolution of gang culture and dynamics that are completely unique from the rest of the country.

This class is recommended for anyone involved in gang investigations or seeking the most updated information involving gang activity on the East Coast.
